HomeFront and NRG Send Over 150 Kids in Mercer County to Camp

— *NRG Energy's \$100,000 Grant Funds HomeFront's Summer Camps Program* —

PRINCETON, NJ; August 19, 2009—For the second year in a row, NRG Energy was the primary sponsor of HomeFront's Summer Camps, a program that provides over 150 less fortunate children in Mercer County with a summer filled with learning, fun and making new friends. This year, with state funding unavailable, NRG's Global Giving program helped keep the summer camps program alive with a \$100,000 grant.

With school out of session and parents at work, the camps give kids a place to go during summertime where they learn about art and music, receive swimming lessons, play team sports and attend off-site field trips. Last year, NRG provided an initial \$150,000 grant, which allowed HomeFront to hire new staff and to continue operation of the seven-week program.

"Working with HomeFront's summer camps program to give campers a safe environment rich with new learning experiences is rewarding—we are glad to support this effort," said David Crane, President and CEO of NRG Energy, on a recent visit to the camp in Ewing.
