# NRG Energy-Funded Renovation of Isles' YouthBuild Institute in Trenton Complete

**PRINCETON, NJ; June 4, 2009–** NRG Energy Inc.'s (NYSE: NRG) million dollar renovation of Isles' YouthBuild Institute in Trenton, NJ is complete. The project nearly tripled the size of the YouthBuild Institute, transforming the old facility, a former paint warehouse, into a remarkable new educational facility for at-risk youth facing extraordinary challenges in central New Jersey.

A ceremonial ribbon cutting at the new school was attended by Trenton Mayor Doug Palmer and Mercer County Executive Brian Hughes, along with NRG President and CEO David Crane, Isles President and CEO Marty Johnson and many of the YouthBuild Institute's students and staff.

"This renovation brings more than just new facilities and electric systems—it brings new opportunities for our youth and countless numbers of future students," said David Crane, President and CEO, NRG Energy at the ceremony.

Isles' YouthBuild Institute is located at 33 Tucker Street in Trenton, NJ. Each year, hundreds of youth in central New Jersey benefit from YouthBuild. YouthBuild provides at-risk youth a path to a high school diploma, a career and greater self-reliance.

In addition to more spacious light-filled classrooms, the renovation added a new library, computer room and woodworking area on the first floor. The second floor, previously empty, was fitted with climate-controlled classrooms, which will be used for energy and solar education, as well as breakout rooms and restrooms. The building also is now 100% handicapped accessible, with new energy efficient heating, cooling and lighting systems.

"As a global energy company, NRG is a step ahead of its peers," said Marty Johnson, President and CEO, Isles, Inc. "They lead by example and push other energy companies to reduce their carbon emissions. NRG is an investor in communities and the future workforce.
