NRG Energy CEO David Crane Receives Transformational Achievement Award from Ernst & Young

PRINCETON, NJ; June 25, 2010—Ernst & Young awarded David Crane, President and CEO of NRG Energy, Inc. (NYSE: NRG), a "Transformational Achievement" award at its annual New Jersey Entrepreneur of the Year award celebration.

This special regional award recognizes Crane's entrepreneurialism, commitment and contribution to changing the debate on climate change and the environment.

NRG Energy was founded in 1989 as a subsidiary of Minneapolis-based Northern States Power Company and spun off as a publicly traded company in 2000. Today, NRG is one of the nation's largest independent wholesale providers of electricity, producing power at nearly 50 facilities concentrated in Texas, the Northeast, Louisiana and California.

Crane was evaluated by an independent panel of judges including regional business, academic and community leaders. As a New Jersey regional award winner, he is eligible for consideration for the Ernst & Young LLP Entrepreneur of the Year's national program.

The Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year awards program celebrates its 24th anniversary this year. The program honors entrepreneurs who have demonstrated exceptionality in such areas as innovation, financial performance and personal commitment to their businesses and communities.
