NRG Energy Triple-Matches Employee Donations to Contribute Nearly \$300,000 for Japan Disaster Relief

PRINCETON, NJ; April 19, 2011—Responding to the devastation and dire humanitarian need of the Japanese people following the March 11 earthquake and tsunami, the employees of NRG Energy, Inc. (NYSE:NRG) raised \$73,000, which the Company triple-matched through its NRG Global Giving program, bringing the total contribution to \$292,000.

"More than 500 employees responded to the call for donations to help the Japanese people in this grave time of need," said David Crane, NRG's President and CEO. "I am proud of the outpouring of assistance by NRG personnel for our friends across the ocean. Our efforts for Japan, as well as recent efforts for those affected by disasters in Queensland, Australia and in Haiti, testify to the great character and generosity of our employees."

Shortly after news of the quake, NRG Global Giving set up a web portal for employees that matched their donations three-to-one, meaning that a \$100 donation generated a Company match of \$300, for a total donation of \$400. The donation was divided between Give2Asia and the Red Cross' Japan Fund, with a portion dispersed to emergency aid groups in prefectures such as Miyagi, Iwate and Fukushima, which saw the most devastation from the event.

"We are most grateful to NRG for supporting the Red Cross relief efforts to assist the people of the Japan earthquake," said Kevin Sullivan, CEO, American Red Cross of Central New Jersey. "NRG and its employees have stepped up to the plate to support the Japanese Red Cross in distributing thousands of comfort items for the 128,000 people in evacuation centers, including blankets, clothes, radios, flashlights, sleeping mats, cleaning tools, instant food, water and air purifiers."

"We are honored to be a recipient of NRG Energy's Global Giving program," said Barnett Baron, Give2Asia's President and CEO. "Give2Asia believes in partnering with local organizations that understand and meet the needs and challenges of survivors and their communities. Our efforts will focus on providing medium- and long-term support so that communities in the affected areas can successfully rebuild."
