Reliant will purchase and retire carbon offsets equal to the participation level that customers select. Carbon offsets for the Reliant EcoShare<sup>SM</sup> program meet approved standards established by organizations respected for their environmental integrity to ensure that they represent real, verifiable reductions in greenhouse gases.

"We developed EcoShare<sup>SM</sup> in response to feedback from customers who told us they are looking for ways to reduce their impact on the environment and support environmental organizations," said Jason Few, President, Reliant Energy. "EcoShare<sup>SM</sup> does that by giving customers a simple way to offset a portion of their carbon footprint while donating to organizations that improve the quality of life right here in Texas."
